MC refers to document ref. SHIF/MC/15/230/AG and approves the agenda.

## Item 2: Approval of the Record of Decisions of the $229^{\text {th }}$ meeting of the Management Committee (SHIF/MC/15/RD.229)

MC refers to document ref. SHIF/MC/15/RD. 229 and decides to approve the Record of Decisions of the $229^{\text {th }}$ meeting of the Management Committee.

## Item 3: Appeal against a decision of the Standing Subcommittee

 for the non-reimbursement of a reflexotherapy treatment provided to an insured member's dependent spouse - Special case 2014 / 04(SHIF/MC/2015/230/3)

The case concerns an appeal made by a staff member against a decision adopted by the Standing Subcommittee not to pay him any benefits in relation to a reflexotherapy treatment provided to his spouse.

MC agrees that the points raised by the staff member in his appeal call for review and comes to the conclusion that the current wording of Code 1.5 ("Functional rehabilitation") of the Fund's Schedule of Benefits and Administrative Rules makes it difficult to reject the payment. MC therefore decides to authorize reimbursement of the treatment, pursuant to the terms and conditions governing Code 1.5 of the Fund's Schedule of Benefits and Administrative Rules.

In addition, MC decides to amend Code 1.5 of the Fund's Regulations and Administrative Rules, by creating a solid legal basis for the future, with a view to eliminating any misinterpretation of the text. The change will be incorporated in the proposed amendments to the SHIF Regulations and Administrative Rules, as discussed under item 4.

## Item 4: Draft circular concerning proposed amendments to the SHIF Regulations and Administrative Rules <br> (SHIF/MC/2015/230/4)

As agreed at the $229^{\text {th }}$ meeting of the MC, the Secretariat has prepared a draft circular informing the insured persons of the proposed amendments to the Fund's Regulations and Administrative Rules.
MC approves the circular.
MC is informed that translating and formatting the circular may take up to 2 months, before it can be sent out to all SHIF insured persons.

Item 5: Draft Report on the Activities of the Fund in 2013 and 2014
MC is informed that the preparation of the Report on the Activities of the Fund has been delayed due to the significant workload of the Secretariat. A draft report will be presented to the MC as soon as possible.
