

TWENTY-FIRST ORDINARY SESSION

***In re* CANTILLON**

Judgment No. 134

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) drawn up by Mrs. Nora Cantillon on 17 September 1968;

A. Considering that in the aforesaid complaint Mrs. Cantillon prays that she be accorded non-local status as from 26 August 1965, with retroactive payment of installation and non-resident allowances and payment of compensation for loss of earnings due to the withholding of the benefits of non-local status;

B. Considering that by letter dated 3 December 1968 the respondent Organization informed the Tribunal that an amicable settlement had been reached between the Organization and complainant; that by letter of 27 February 1969 addressed to the Tribunal complainant confirmed that such an agreement had been reached and stated that she withdraws her complaint unreservedly;

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit by Mrs. Cantillon is hereby recorded.
