

TWENTY-SECOND ORDINARY SESSION

***In re* BOULMIER and MORIZOT**

Judgment No. 143

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaints against the International Labour Organisation (ILO) drawn up by Miss André Boulmier and Miss Raymonde Morizot on 30 September 1968 and the Organisation's reply to each of these complaints dated 15 November 1968;

A. Considering that these two complaints deal with the same question and that they should be joined for settlement by a single judgment;

B. Considering that the complainants request the quashing of the decision of the Director-General of the International Labour Office dated 21 December 1967 and of the decision of the Governing Body of the International Labour Organisation, dated 29 February 1968, both of which relate to the salaries of the General Service Category Officials of the ILO, on the ground that these decisions prejudice the position of the complainants under the Staff Regulations and their acquired rights deriving therefrom;

C. Considering that the Organisation submits that the Tribunal lacks jurisdiction to hear the two complaints; subsidiarily, that it should declare them to be irreceivable; and very subsidiarily, that it should dismiss them as unfounded;

D. Considering that by a letter of 12 June 1969 communicated to the Registry of the Tribunal the complainants expressed to the Tribunal their desire to withdraw their complaints, following a general agreement made between the officials of the category to which they belong and the ILO Administration, and that the International Labour Organisation, having been notified of the above, has informed the Tribunal that it sees no reason to continue the proceedings in these cases;

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit by Miss Boulmier and Miss Morizot is hereby recorded.
