

## **EIGHTY-NINTH SESSION**

***In re* Palma (No. 2)  
(Application for review)**

**Judgment No. 1998**

The Administrative Tribunal,

Considering the second complaint filed by Mr Francesco Palma against the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) on 20 September 1999 and which constitutes an application for review of Judgment 1665;

Considering Article II, paragraph 5, of the Statute of the Tribunal and Article 7 of its Rules;

Having examined the written submissions;

### **CONSIDERATIONS**

The complainant seeks review of Judgment 1665, in which the Tribunal dismissed a complaint he had filed against a decision by the Governing Body of the CERN Pension Fund. The complaint is unsubstantiated and therefore clearly irreceivable. It must be dismissed according to the summary procedure provided for in Article 7 of the Rules of the Tribunal.

### **DECISION**

For the above reasons,

The application is dismissed.
