Judgment No. 2909

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the fourth application for review of Judgment 1484 filed by Mr P. T.-C. on 16 September 2008;

Considering Article II, paragraph 5, of the Statute of the Tribunal and Article 7 of its Rules;

Having examined the written submissions and disallowed the complainant's application for hearings;

CONSIDERATIONS

- 1. By Judgment 1484 the Tribunal set aside a decision of the Director-General of the World Health Organization (WHO) of 17 May 1994 confirming a decision of 30 August 1993 to terminate the complainant's appointment. The Tribunal ordered WHO to pay the complainant damages equal to the salary that he would have earned had his appointment been maintained until the end of his contract, that is to say until 31 March 1994, as well as 2,500 Swiss francs in costs.
- 2. By Judgments 2166, 2265 and 2617, the Tribunal dismissed three applications for review filed by the complainant against Judgment 1484.

3. In his fourth application for review the complainant in substance reiterates his previous criticism, but he does not put forward any pleas or claims which would warrant the review which he requests. The Tribunal must therefore dismiss this new application for review in accordance with the summary procedure provided for in Article 7 of its Rules.

DECISION

For the above reasons, The application is dismissed.
