THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the fourth application for review filed by Mr. Jacques Verdrager on 21 January 1981 in the case of Verdrager versus the World Health Organization (WHO);

Considering Article II, paragraph 5, of the Statute of the Tribunal and Article 8, paragraph 3, of the Rules of Court;

Having examined the written evidence;

CONSIDERATIONS:

In his fourth application for review of Judgment No. 325 the complainant objects that in dismissing his third application in Judgment No. 439 the Tribunal omitted to take account of one line in an item of evidence. In other words he is objecting to the Tribunal's evaluation of evidence, and that is not a plea which can afford grounds for review.

DECISION:

For the above reasons.

The complaint is dismissed.
