THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint brought against the European Patent Organization (EPO) by Mr. Gerard Boersma on 17 April 1980 and the EPO's reply of 25 June 1980;

- A. Considering that the complainant asked the Tribunal to order that he should be graded at B5, step 11, with effect from 1 September 1979;
- B. Considering that by a letter of 28 January 1981 to the Registrar of the Tribunal the complainant stated that, having obtained full satisfaction, he whished to withdraw suit;
- C. Considering that by a letter of 10 February 1981 the EPO informed the Registrar that it had no objection to the withdrawal of suit;
- D. Considering that suit is unreservedly withdrawn;

DECISION:
