PART OF GLOBAL PROGRAMMES

1. Extension of social security through social dialogue (Mali)

SPECIFIC AFRICAN PROGRAMMES

1. Extension of social security to the excluded in five Portuguese-speaking African countries (Angola, Cape Verde, Guinea-Bissau, Mozambique and São Tomé & Príncipe)
2. Extension of social protection through Health Micro Insurance for women and their families (Benin, Burkina Faso, Guinea-Conakry and Senegal).
3. Co-ordination among actors of the development of mutual health organizations in West and Central Africa (Benin, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Senegal and Togo).
4. Defining a legal framework for the development of mutual health organizations in the West African Monetary Union (WAMU) (Benin, Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Guinea-Conakry, Mali, Niger, Senegal and Togo).
5. Fight against poverty and extension of social protection to women working in the informal sector (Burkina Faso and Ethiopia).
6. Extension of social protection in the informal economy (The Gambia)
7. Development of a social security strategy (Sierra Leone).
8. Feasibility of unifying national social security schemes (Sudan).
9. Restructuring of social insurance pension schemes based on actuarial valuation (Tanzania)
