

SEVENTEENTH ITEM ON THE AGENDA

Report of the Director-General

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I. Composition of the Organization

1. Article 1, paragraph 3, of the Constitution and article 27 of the Standing Orders of the International Labour Conference provide that a Member of the United Nations may become a Member of the International Labour Organization by communicating to the Director-General its acceptance of the obligations of the Constitution.

Entry of the Republic of Vanuatu

2. By a letter dated 17 April 2003 and received on 22 May 2003 the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu, which is a Member of the United Nations, communicated to the Director-General its formal acceptance of the obligations of the Constitution of the International Labour Organization. Vanuatu accordingly became the 176th Member of the ILO on 22 May 2003.

Entry of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste

3. By a letter dated 22 July 2003 and received 19 August 2003, the Government of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, which is a Member of the United Nations, communicated to the Director-General its formal acceptance of the obligations of the Constitution of the International Labour Organization. Timor-Leste accordingly became the 177th Member of the ILO on 19 August 2003.

II. Progress in international labour legislation

Ratifications of Conventions and Protocols to Conventions

4. Since the preparation of the document submitted to the 288th Session of the Governing Body, the Director-General has registered the following 17 ratifications of international labour Conventions, bringing the total number of ratifications registered on 30 January 2004 to 7,180. Denunciations of Conventions

Lithuania

- 5. The Director-General registered, on 11 November 2003, the denunciation by Lithuania of the Night Work (Women) Convention, 1919 (No. 4). The text of the communication concerning the denunciation by Lithuania of this Convention reads as follows: "... the said Convention was revised on 6 June 1990 by the Convention concerning night work (No. 171) which was ratified by the SEIMAS (Parliament) of the Republic of Lithuania on 26 September 1994".
- **6.** The Government also indicated that, in accordance with the Tripartite Consultation (International Labour Standards) Convention, 1976 (No. 144), consultations on proposals for the denunciation of Convention No. 4 were held with the most representative employers' and workers' organizations.

Ratification/acceptance of the Constitution of the International Labour Organization Instrument of Amendment, 1997

- **7.** Since the preparation of the document submitted to the 288th Session of the Governing Body, the Director-General has received no further ratification or acceptance of the instrument. The total number of ratifications and acceptances thus remains 76, including six States of chief industrial importance.
- **8.** The Director-General hopes that, further to the 2002 ratification campaign requested by the Governing Body, the pace of conveyance of the 44 ratifications or acceptances still necessary for the amendment to come into force will henceforth be accelerated.

III. Internal administration

9. Article 4.2(d) of the Staff Regulations states:

Vacancies in the Director and Principal Officer category shall be filled by the Director-General by transfer in the same grade, promotion or appointment. Such promotions or appointments, other than to vacancies in technical cooperation projects, shall be reported to the Governing Body with a short statement of the qualifications of the persons so promoted or appointed.

10. The following appointments and promotions are accordingly reported to the Governing Body:

Mr. I. Ahmed (Bangladesh)

Mr. Iftikhar Ahmed is appointed Director of the Publications Bureau (PUBL) with effect from 1 July 2003, while continuing as Editor-in-Chief of the International Labour Review Section (REVUE). Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in March 2001.

Mr. J. Baker (United States)

Mr. James Baker is appointed Director of the Bureau for Workers' Activities (ACTRAV) at the D.2 level with effect from 1 December 2003. Born in 1953. Graduated in 1971 from the Springfield High School, Oregon, United States.

Prior to joining the ILO, Mr. Baker held the post of Director of Multinational Enterprises at the International Confederation of Free Trade Unions (ICFTU) in Brussels where he was responsible for organization and recruitment. His department worked with global union federations and national centres on campaigns, global social dialogue, and other activities related to MNEs, as well as efforts to stimulate and support trade union organizing. Mr. Baker held several positions in the American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations (AFL-CIO), including Executive Assistant to the President. He was European representative of the AFL-CIO for nine years and served on the ILO Governing Body from 1986 to 1991. Before becoming a trade union official, Mr. Baker was an autoworker employed by the Ford Motor Company and a member of the United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers' International Union (UAW), Local 560.

Mr. C. Dan (Benin)

Mr. Charles Dan is appointed Director of the ILO Preparatory Team to the African Union Extraordinary Summit of Heads of State and Government on Employment and Poverty Alleviation, in addition to his functions in the Office of the Director-General, and promoted to D.1 with effect from 1 November 2003. Born in 1960, Mr. Dan graduated from the Université Paris II, Assas, with a Masters in Public Law, from the Université Paris I, La Sorbonne, with a Diplôme d'Etudes Approfondies in Public Law, and from the Institut d'Etudes Politiques in Paris, France.

Mr. Dan joined the ILO in 1994 as Senior Specialist in Employers' Activities in the ILO Multidisciplinary Advisory Team in Dakar. In 1997, he was transferred to the Bureau for Employers' Activities (ACT/EMP) in Geneva as official responsible for relations with African employers. Since 1999, he has been a member of the Office of the Director-General.

Prior to joining the ILO, Mr. Dan worked for the International Organisation of Employers (IOE) where he successively held the positions of Assistant to the Secretary-General, Deputy Executive Secretary and Executive Secretary.

Mr. D. Duysens (Belgium)

Mr. Daniel Duysens is appointed Deputy Regional Director of the ILO Regional Office for Africa with effect from 1 November 2003. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in November 1995.

Ms. A. Ouedraogo (Burkina Faso)

Ms. Alice Ouedraogo is appointed Director of the ILO Subregional Office for Central Africa in Yaoundé with effect from 1 March 2004. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in November 1999.
