Effect to be given to the recommendations of sectoral and technical meetings

(a) Meeting of Experts on Safety and Health in Coal Mines

(Geneva, 8-13 May 2006)

- **1.** The Meeting of Experts on Safety and Health in Coal Mines was held in Geneva from 8 to 13 May 2006. It was chaired by Ms. May Hermanus, an external consultant.
- **2.** The experts reviewed and amended a draft code of practice on safety and health in underground coalmines. They also made a number of recommendations for follow-up action by the ILO.
- **3.** The experts unanimously adopted the new code of practice on safety and health in underground coalmines, ¹ which will replace one adopted by a meeting of experts in 1985 (published in 1986), a set of recommendations for follow-up action ² and a report of their discussion, ³ as amended by the Meeting.
- 4. The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body:
 - (i) take note of the report of the Meeting of Experts and authorize the Director-General to publish the code of practice on safety and health in underground coalmines; and
