Project Objective

To support the design and development of a labour market information system in key provinces, to improve the institutional capacity for human resources development planning, and to support the improved quality and relevance of skills training.

Project Outcomes

- Systems to disseminate labour market information and analysis are established at both the central level and provincial level.
- The range and quality of available labour market information, and the capacity to analyse and use this information for policies is improved.
- MOLISA and key stakeholders have developed and piloted a market-focused approach to elaborating National Skills Standards frameworks, assessment and certification systems.

Main Activities

- Centre for labour market information established in MOLISA linked to labour market units in selected provinces.
- Staff in Centres for Employment Services trained in using a management information system, and a training programme for training centre management is developed.
