Recommendations

- 1. Build capacity of stakeholders involved in labour migration management to use digital tools.
- 2. Develop systems to oversee migration information that is publically available on line for accuracy and to make sure it is current
- 3. Use digital tools to support networking among migrant workers overseas and to maintain contact with home country
- 4. Develop online job matching portals which are easily accessible and user friendly.
- 5. Make use of free software and applications (such as facebook and google, viber) when developing digital services for migrants.
- 6. Use digital tools to offer pre departure and post arrival trainings and information to potential migrants.
- 7. To develop friendly digital tools for migrants to access accurate and up to date information about countries of destination (currency, do's and don'ts, culture)
- 8. Promote use of legal online banking for safer, cheaper and quicker transfers of migrants remittances
- 9. Develop an online Complaints mechanism that is easily accessible; and which can track the progress of the response to the complaint.
