The Global Accelerator: WHY?

Long-term challenges:

• climate change, demographic transitions, digital transformation, persisting high levels of informality and gender inequality, care crises.

Compounded by multiple crises

- Food, energy, debt
- And weak and uneven recovery (growth, labour markets), result in:
 - Poverty, inequality, and hunger on the rise again. Progress reversed.

=> Need for scaled-up investments to tackle root causes and structural constraints


Global political support Multilateral cooperation in action – one UN and beyond!




Three tracks resource mobilization process

- **1. Joint SDG Fund Window**: catalytic funding under UNRC leadership To be launched in April 2024.
- 2. Direct funding to ILO/UN global and country level projects
- 3. Alignment of bilateral cooperation with objectives of the Accelerator at country level
