**Effect to be given to the recommendations
of sectoral and technical meetings****Tripartite Meeting on Promoting Social
Dialogue and Good Industrial Relations
from Oil and Gas Exploration and
Production to Oil and Gas Distribution
(Geneva, 11–14 May 2009)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on Promoting Social Dialogue and Good Industrial Relations from Oil and Gas Exploration and Production to Oil and Gas Distribution was held in Geneva from 11 to 14 May 2009, chaired by Mr Göran Trogen, Employer member of the Governing Body.
2. The Meeting was attended by Government representatives from: Algeria, Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Haiti, Indonesia, Latvia, Lebanon, Malaysia, Niger, Nigeria, Norway, Philippines, Poland, South Africa, Thailand and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, as well as 17 Employer and nine Worker representatives. Representatives from the following international inter-governmental organizations attended as observers: the International Energy Agency (IEA) and the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD). Representatives from the following international non-governmental organizations also attended as observers: the International Trade Union Confederation (ITUC), the International Federation of Chemical, Energy, Mine and General Workers' Unions (ICEM), the International Transport Workers' Federation (ITF) and the International Organisation of Employers (IOE).
3. The Meeting considered a report ¹ prepared by the Office. It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions, which, together with a summary of proceedings of the Meeting, appears in the *Note on the proceedings*. ² Paragraphs 21–23 of the conclusions concerning follow-up activities call for action by the ILO.

4. *The Committee may wish to recommend that the Governing Body:*

- (a) *authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the proceedings containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above to governments, requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned; to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned; and to the international organizations concerned; and***

- (b) *request the Director-General to bear in mind, when drawing up proposals for the future work of the Office, the conclusions of the Meeting.***
