Bahamas

Serious failure to submit instruments adopted by the Conference to the competent authorities

The Government has provided the following written information.

During the 106th Session of the International Labour Conference, Geneva, June 2017, the Bahamas acknowledged its serious failure to submit at the Committee on the Application of Standards. At the time, the Bahamas advised the Committee that it would rectify its position and further advised that it was in need of technical assistance from the International Labour Organization in order to do so.

While there was minor dialogue after the Conference, and then the onset of the Covid-19 Pandemic, the Bahamas did not ascertain assistance until late 2021 through the Caribbean ILO technical secretariat. Gratefully, with this technical assistance presently afforded, the Bahamas anticipates beginning the submission process to the competent authority by the end of 2022 or sooner.

At this time, gratitude is extended to the International Labour Organization for its continued understanding and support.
