**Effect to be given to the recommendations
of sectoral meetings**

**Tripartite Meeting on Labour and Social
Issues arising from Problems of Cross-
border Mobility of International Drivers
in the Road Transport Sector
(Geneva, 23–26 October 2006)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on Labour and Social Issues arising from Problems of Cross-border Mobility of International Drivers in the Road Transport Sector was held in Geneva from 23 to 26 October 2006, chaired by Mr. Peter Tomek, Employer member of the Governing Body.
2. The Meeting considered a report¹ prepared by the International Labour Office. It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions.
3. The text, together with a summary of proceedings of the Meeting, appears in the *Note on the proceedings*,² which accompanies the present paper. Paragraph 20 of the conclusions concerning follow-up activities calls for action by the ILO.
4. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the proceedings containing the text mentioned in paragraph 3 above:*
 - (a) *to governments, requesting them to communicate this text to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*

(b) to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned;

(c) to the other international organizations concerned.

5. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may also wish to recommend that the Governing Body request the Director-General to bear in mind, when drawing up proposals for the future work of the Office, the wishes expressed by the Meeting in paragraph 20 of the conclusions regarding follow-up activities by the ILO.*
