

**FAMILY STATUS DISCRIMINATION
(PROCEEDINGS BY EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES
COMMISSION) REGULATION**

2. **Circumstances in which Commission may bring proceedings**

The circumstances in which the Commission may bring proceedings for the purposes of section 54(1) of the Ordinance (as if it were a person who may have brought proceedings under that section but has not done so) are where—

- (a) the case raises a question of principle; and
- (b) it is in the interests of justice to do so,

and it appears to the Commission that the claim of the person is well founded.

3. **Remedies Commission may seek in proceedings brought by it**

In any proceedings brought under section 2, the Commission may apply for any remedy available to a claimant under section 54(3) of the Ordinance including a declaration that the act which is the subject of the proceedings is an unlawful act or an injunction in respect of such act or both a declaration and an injunction.
