AN ACT to alter the Constitution.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1.(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles (Seventh Amendment) Act, 2016.

Short title

(2) This Act shall come into operation on such date as the President may, by notice in the Gazette, appoint.

2. The Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles is amended as follows—

- (a) in Article 52, by repealing in clause (2) the word “three” and substituting therefor the word “two”;
- (b) in Article 52A., by repealing in clause (2) the words “or second”;
- (c) in Article 66A,—
 - (i) by repealing in clause (7) the words “3 terms” and substituting therefor the words “2 terms”;
 - (ii) by repealing in clause (12) the words “2 other terms” and substituting therefor the words “1 more term”.
