The Labor [Code](#) of the Republic of Uzbekistan (Newsletter of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 1996, addendum to No. 1) and No. 207 of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 12, 2008 "Convention on the Minimum Age for Employment and Child Labor Ratified by the Republic of Uzbekistan" In accordance with the decision "On measures to implement the Convention on emergency measures for the prohibition and elimination of severe forms of illegal drugs" (collection of laws of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 2008, No. [37-38](#) , Article 377) of the Labor and Social Protection of the Republic of Uzbekistan The Ministry and the Ministry of Health decide:

1. The regulation on determining the limit of heavy loads that can be lifted and transported by persons under the age of eighteen should be approved in accordance with the [appendix](#) .

2. This decision shall enter into force ten days after its state registration in the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

**On determining the limit of heavy loads that can be lifted and transported by persons
under the age of eighteen**

REGULATION

This Regulation is in accordance with the Labor [Code](#) of the Republic of Uzbekistan (Newsletter of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 1996, supplement No. 1) and the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 207 of September 12, 2008 "Convention on the Minimum Age for Employment Ratified by the Republic of Uzbekistan and In accordance with the decision "On Measures for the Implementation of the Convention on Urgent Measures to Prohibit and Eliminate Severe Forms of Child Labor" ([Collection](#) of Laws of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 2008, No. 37-38, Article 377) lifting persons under the age of eighteen and determines the limit of heavy load norms that can be transported.

I. General rules

1. Regardless of the form of ownership, this Regulation must be applied to the labor relations of all enterprises, organizations and institutions, as well as individuals working under a labor contract (contract) at the discretion of some citizens.

2. The requirements of this Regulation should be taken into account in the development and production of stylistic manuals in the educational system.

**II. Permissible standards for lifting and transporting loads for persons under the age of
eighteen**

3. When one-third of the working time of persons from sixteen to eighteen years of age is related to lifting and carrying loads, the limit of lifting and carrying norms for them is determined in accordance with the [addendum](#) to this Regulation.

4. When the working time of persons from sixteen to eighteen years of age consists only of carrying and carrying loads by hand, the limit of carrying and carrying loads for them should not be heavier than 4.1 kg, as well as they are involved in carrying loads with the help of wheelchairs and trolleys. should not be done.

5. When one-third of the working time of minors under the age of sixteen consists of lifting and carrying loads by hand, the limit of the norms of lifting and carrying loads by hand: for boys - 6.5 kg, for girls - 3.5 kg. should not be heavy.

6. When the working time of minors under the age of sixteen consists only of lifting and carrying loads by hand, the limit of carrying and carrying loads for them should not exceed 2 kg.

7. Minors under the age of sixteen are not allowed to carry cargo with the help of strollers and wagons.

III. The first rule

This Regulation was agreed with the Council of the Federation of Trade Unions of Uzbekistan and the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

ADDENDUM to the regulation on determining the limit of heavy loads that can be lifted and transported by persons under the age of eighteen

When one-third of the working time consists of carrying and carrying loads, the limits of the lifting and carrying norms of persons from sixteen to eighteen years of age

Lifting and transportation types	The limit of the load norm		Pick up and delivery conditions
	for boys	for girls	
In hand	up to 13 kg	up to 7 kg	it is allowed if the imaginary height does not exceed 0.01
One-wheeled cart	up to 39 kg	girls are not allowed	it is allowed to move only on a boardwalk with a vertical height of not more than 0.02
Two-wheeled stroller	up to 47 kg	girls are not allowed	it is allowed to move on a flat road with an imaginary height not higher than 0.02 it is allowed to drive on uneven roads and bridges with a vertical height of no more than 0.01
Three- and four-wheeled carts	up to 67 kg	up to 52 kg	it is allowed to move on a flat road with an imaginary height not higher than 0.02
In wagons	up to 405 kg	up to 224 kg	it is allowed to move on railways with a horizontal height of not more than 0.01

Note:

1. All load norms include the weight of the load, as well as the devices that can lift and transport them.
2. The height of the permitted curb means the maximum height of the curb in relation to the length of the road.
