Recommendations Employers' Group Discussion

PNG, Port Moresby, 24-27 July 2019

1	SDGs	Tripartite	More awareness raising, capacity building, and social dialogue on SDG 8 and its implementation, with particular attention to the macroeconomic dimensions
2	Digitalization	Government	 Government creating an enabling environment for policy making and investment through social dialogue and private sector collaboration to harness the opportunities presented by technology while managing the potential social, cultural, and economic challenges.
3	Labour Migration	Government	 Evidence-based review of the labour mobility schemes to revisit the framework, capture lessons learned and recommendations for better management and coordination within the region, including with the private sector and workers associations. Pilot new services such as migrant resource centres to deliver pre-departure services and upon return/arrival.

4	Climate Change	Government	 Prioritize dialogue and collaboration with the private sector on investment in climate resilient infrastructure and the policy environment needed to promote enterprise resiliency, including SME.
5	Other Issues	ILO	 The ILO should provide policy guidance and technical assistance to reboot skills development based firmly on national labour market needs and forecasts developed in genuine cooperation with social partners
		Government	Coherent policy and consistent implementation and enforcement of laws and regulations.

Strengthen the capacity of PIPSO as a regional body to represent employers and seek formal recognition from the ILO and all other key stakeholders.
