<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 500 children withdrawn from hazardous child labour through the provision of educational and other services. ○ 5,500 children withdrawn from work ○ 1,000 children prevented from entering hazardous child labour. ○ Credit facilities, social safety nets and health services. ○ Provided access to formal and non-formal education, and vocational training for children in labour and to those at risk. ○ Strengthened capacity of target district governments to address child labour concerns. ○ Enhanced support mechanisms at provincial and federal levels to support policy and action to combat child labour. ○ Improved knowledge-base, policies and legislative framework.
