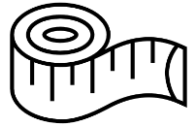

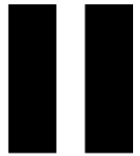
# Data Disruptions Due to COVID-19

Research Data Centres (RDCs) closed down



Draw on new access points (e.g., RTRA)



Response Rates Collapsed in Key Surveys

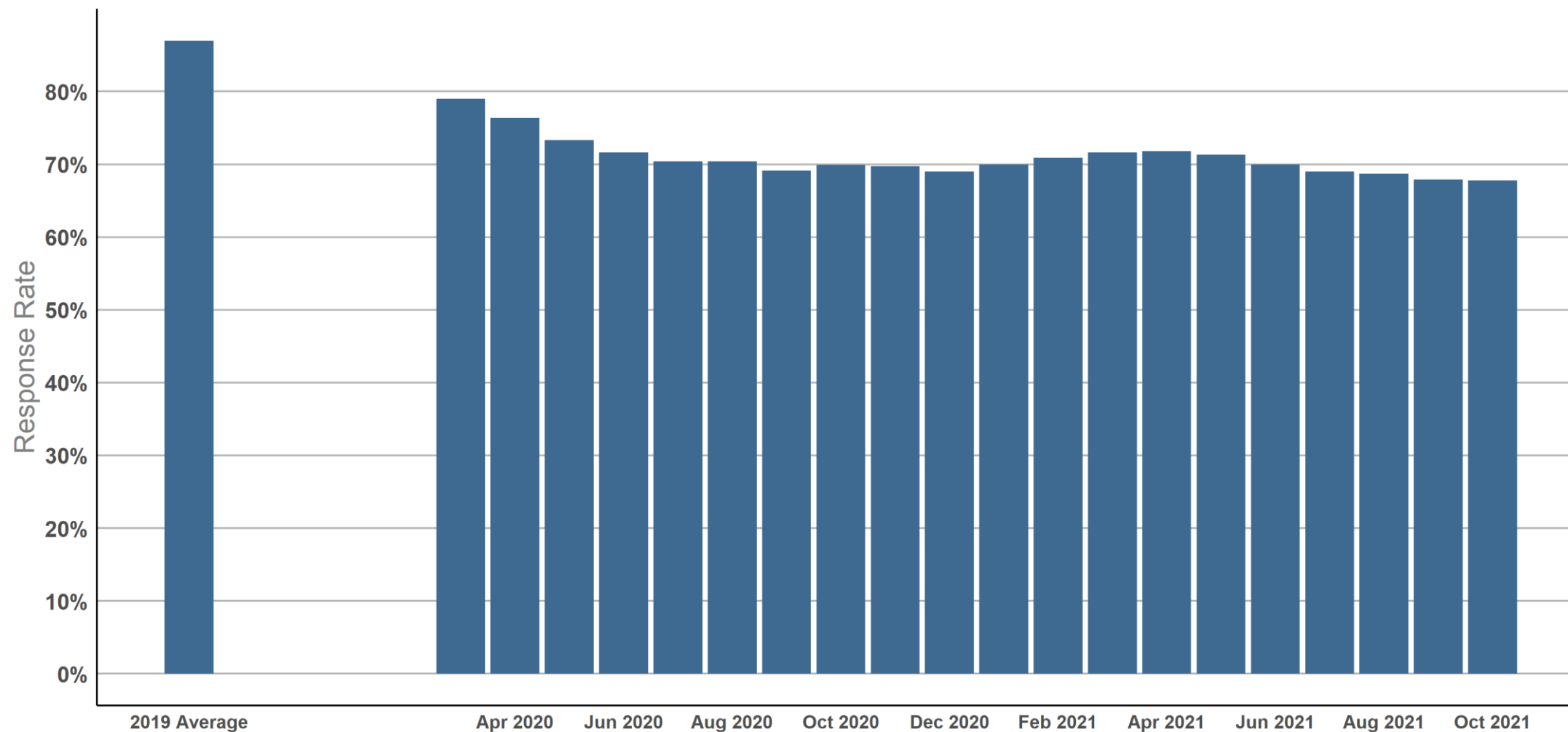

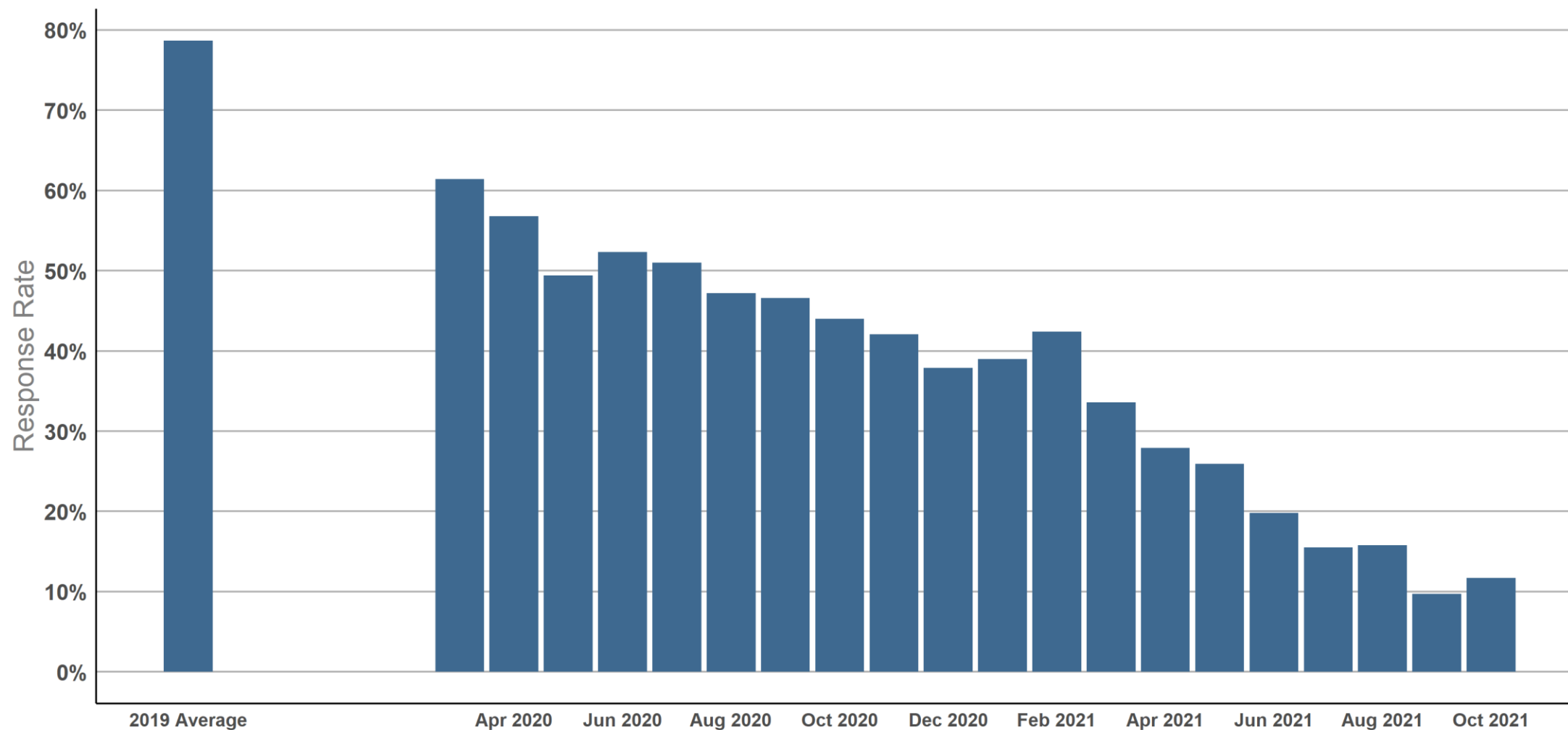
# LFS Response Rate Remains Low

# ... But Far Worse in Remote Regions

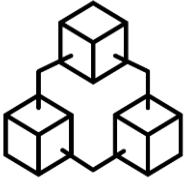
Response rate to Labour Force Survey, Nunavut

Improved administrative data - timeliness

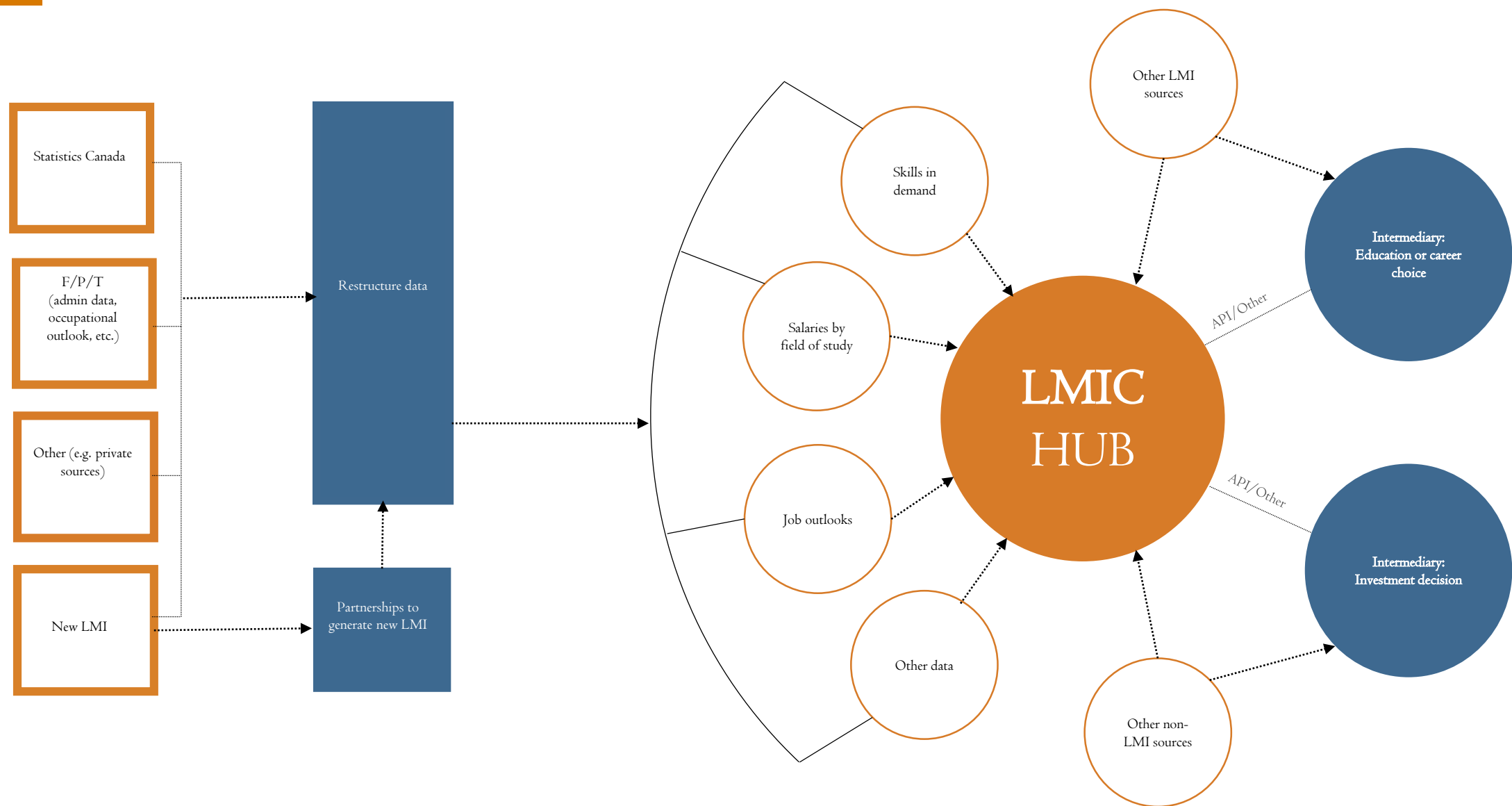


A central repository of labour market **relevant** data:
