Update on the high-level tripartite mission to the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela

Summary: Update on the organization of a high-level tripartite mission to the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela in accordance with the Governing Body's decision of March 2011.

1. At its 310th Session (March 2011), the Governing Body decided to request the Director-General to send a high-level tripartite mission to the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela to address all the issues before the Governing Body, related to Case No. 2254, as well as technical cooperation matters. As a result of that decision, the procedure filed under article 26 of the ILO Constitution in June 2004 would be closed.
2. The Government had proposed receiving the high-level mission between 15 and 19 October 2012 or at a later date. However, on account of certain unresolved matters and following consultations with the Officers of the Governing Body, it has been decided to postpone the high-level tripartite mission to a date to be agreed upon by the parties, and which would be no later than February 2013.
3. Accordingly, and in response to the Governing Body's request for information,¹ the Director-General will present the full report of the high-level tripartite mission to the Governing Body, once the mission has concluded its work.
