Addendum

Draft decision

- 1. Taking into account the information contained in the report of the mission to the Republic of Guatemala, ¹ the Officers of the Governing Body recommend that the Governing Body should:
 - (a) defer until its 323rd Session (March 2015) the decision on the appointment of a commission of inquiry;
 - (b) request the Office to provide the Governing Body, at its 323rd Session (March 2015), with updated information on the progress made, including information provided by the Government and the employers' and workers' organizations in Guatemala, in particular on the follow-up given to the elements of the roadmap;
 - (c) include this item on the agenda of its 323rd Session (March 2015) in order to decide whether other measures need to be adopted in relation to this complaint; and
 - (d) invite the international community to facilitate the necessary resources to enable the ILO Country Office in Guatemala to continue to support the tripartite constituents in the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding and the roadmap.
