Report of the Director-General

Third Supplementary Report: Replacement of a member of a Governing Body committee set up to examine a representation submitted in accordance with article 24 of the ILO Constitution

1. At its 329th Session (March 2017), the Governing Body appointed Mr Diego Cano Soler (Spain) as the Government member in the tripartite committee it set up at the same session to examine the representation alleging non-observance by France of the Termination of Employment Convention, 1982 (No. 158), made under article 24 of the ILO Constitution by the General Confederation of Labour–Force Ouvrière (CGT–FO) and the General Confederation of Labour (CGT).¹
2. Following the Governing Body elections held in June 2017, Spain ceased to hold a Government seat in the Governing Body. The Government group is accordingly called upon to designate among its regular or deputy members of the Governing Body a representative to replace Mr Diego Cano Soler in the tripartite committee referred to above.

Draft decision

3. *The Governing Body appoints a Government member nominated by the Government group in the tripartite committee responsible for the examination of the representation alleging non-observance by France of the Termination of Employment Convention, 1982 (No. 158), made under article 24 of the ILO Constitution by the General Confederation of Labour–Force Ouvrière (CGT–FO) and the General Confederation of Labour (CGT).*
