Zimbabwe-South Africa Bi-national Consultation Workshop

Gaborone, Botswana, 26 February 2014

A tripartite bi-national meeting between representatives of Ministries of Labour and National Affairs -in charge of migration issues-, workers and employers organizations from Zimbabwe and South Africa was held on 26 February 2014 in Gaborone, Botswana, on the margins of the South African Development Countries (SADC) *Joint Technical Tripartite Sub-committees meeting on Employment and Labour Sector programmes*.

The aim of the meeting was to present main objectives, consult on and discuss the priorities of South African and Zimbabwean stakeholders to be incorporated in the work plan of the EU funded Global Action Programme on Migrant Domestic Workers and their Families (GAP-MDW). Constituents discussed the approach of the project as well as national and bi-national activities to be developed. They highlighted the importance of the bi-national dialogue and the participation of social partners in the implementation of the project.

The Programme was also presented during the *Experts meeting on employment and labour migration* (25 February 2014), followed by a lively discussion and the request of Lesotho delegation to be incorporated in the activities of the Programme.
