## Communication sent to Governing Body members on 23 July 2020 for decision-making by correspondence on several topics

Dear members of the Governing Body,

The tripartite Screening Group met on 16 July 2020 to discuss outstanding matters relating to the agenda of the 340th session of the Governing Body, the agenda of the 109th Session of the International Labour Conference, as well as the programme and composition of official meetings. It recommended that a number of decisions be made without delay, in particular regarding the postponement of two official meetings scheduled for September 2020 and the election of the Governing Body Officers for the period 2020–21, in line with the same procedures followed in the previous consultations by correspondence.

At its next meeting scheduled for the end of August 2020, the tripartite Screening Group may recommend further decisions to be made by correspondence. The documents considered by the Screening Group and the minutes of its last seven meetings are posted on the web page of the 338th Session of the Governing Body, once they are approved by the Screening Group.

You are therefore kindly invited to reply to this message by indicating your response with respect to each of the following draft decisions recommended by the Screening Group. To be accounted for, responses must be received by midnight (Geneva time) on Friday, 31 July 2020.
